Mr Chanetsa is the South African representative and plenary member of the Regulatory Oversight Committee (ROC) of the Global Legal Entity Identifier System.

Mr Chanetsa has extensive local and international experience in legal practice and financial services and has worked for various entities in the USA, Australia, Canada and South Africa.

Mr Chanetsa holds a Bachelor of Law, LLB, Juris Doctor degrees. He is a member of the Law Society of the Northern Provinces, the American Bar Association (Vice Chair, International Securities and Capital Markets Committee Section on International Law) and the Financial Services Institute of Australasia (Senior Associate).
